The Pam Baker Scholarships in Human Rights was established in March 2002 for the purpose of honouring the work of Pam Baker, the late human rights lawyer, in furthering the protection of human rights in Hong Kong. The Scholarship will be awarded annually to qualified local students pursuing the Master of Laws (LLM) in Human Rights Programme at the University of Hong Kong. The scholarship aims to promote the recognition of human rights and the furtherance of the rule of law in Hong Kong.

IMPORTANT NOTES TO APPLICANTS

1. An applicant should be a Hong Kong permanent resident who has applied for the LLM(HR) Programme 2021-2022.
2. The scholarship shall be awarded on the basis of the following selection criteria:
 - a. *strong academic performance in previous courses of study;*
 - b. *demonstrated interest or achievement in the area of human rights;*
 - c. *proven personal qualities, e.g.: enthusiasm, initiative, service to community; and*
 - d. *proven financial need (if applicable).*
